

Dear Governor, Date

- •Please stop the annual slaughter of fall-migrating American eels at Maine hydro-electric dams.
- •Turbine mortality estimates are 50-100% per dam!
- •Mature migrating eels [15-50 years old] can harbor extremely high contaminant levels that are re-introduced into our local ecosystems when the eels are killed by turbines.
- •Turbine mutilation and death of eels occurs with the full complicity of Maine's natural resource agencies and your office.
- •The executive office [Dick Davies] was fully briefed on this subject by Friends of Merrymeeting Bay, at your 2005 Wildlife Appreciation Day.
- •Both the Department and board of Environmental Protection refuse to require screening of turbines or night-time turbine shutdowns in combination with alternative passage for out-migrating eels.
- •Federal Clean Water Act and Maine BEP goals require physical, chemical and biological integrity of our waters.
- •Maine water quality standards require suitable habitat for all indigenous fish species.
- •Maine river anti-degradation language requires no back sliding from existing uses [which would include preservation of native fish].
- •Maine's elver fishery is among the least regulated on the east coast with over 16 million elvers reported harvested in 2006.
- •Dams without upstream eel ramps block 85-90% of eel habitat.
- •American eels are a keystone species of our river systems and also have been of great economic importance.
- •Protective laws are on the books. They are not being enforced. We can have eels and electricity.
